

Preparation for Flea Control Requires 2 treatments, 3-5 days apart

- Remove all bedding from home including blankets, sheet and pillows
- Remove all clothing from closets and drawers
 - While technicians are completing treatment, take all bedding and clothes to the laundry matt to be hot washed; Temperature above 95°F will kill fleas and eggs
 - o Place clean clothes and bedding in new bags and keep contained between treatments
- Place all sensitive belongings such as children's toys in a plastic bag so they are not exposed during treatment
 - Before bagging sensitive items, do a visual inspection of items to ensure there are no fleas on them
 - o For children's items that aren't bagged, handwash with water before use
- Remove all items from kitchen cabinets and drawers as technicians need access to all areas
- Remove all clutter from against the wall like boxes and light furniture to reduce obstacles for technician
- Optional: Remove all cushions off couches and chairs and place next to it
- Any animals should be brought to receive a flea bath while technician is completing treatment
- Prepare to leave structure immediately upon technicians' arrival for 4-6 hours

In Between treatments:

- Minimal food should be left out
- Sink immediately cleaned out
- Bagged food items should be left in bag
