Rodent Information:

The house mouse is the number one invader pest in all parts of the country, urban and rural areas as well. A single mouse eats only about 3 grams of food per day (8 pounds per year). However, because of their habit of nibbling on many foods and discarding partially eaten items, the amount of food contaminated is about ten times greater. Nibbling and gnawing of electrical wires can lead to house fires. Droppings can cause salmonella and pulmonary disease. Mice are sexually mature as early as 6 to 10 weeks old and may breed year-round. In perfect conditions, a nest of mice can deposit 18,000 droppings and produce 2,500 heirs in a six-month period. Infestations may be linked as a catalyst for the spreading of many diseases that are harmful to humans.
